We will prepare your 2022 federal and state income tax returns. We will depend on you to provide the information we need to prepare complete and accurate returns. We may ask you to clarify some items but will not audit or otherwise verify the data you submit. An Organizer is enclosed to help you collect the data required for your return. We will perform accounting services only as needed to prepare your tax returns. Our work will not include procedures to find defalcations or other irregularities.
